Public Safety director's Report for: **July**

1. **STAFFING:** We are currently down one full-time member and we are advertising for this position, the other two shifts have five full-time members on their crews. We currently have twelve part-time members on the department. Part-time EMT Pete Huneck recently retired with over 23.5 Years of service on the Tomah Area Ambulance Service, I thank Pete for all he has done for the Tomah community. Candi has been putting in a few hours in her new role as the bookkeeping clerk, she is excited to be in her new position. Candi will continue to help out the Treasurer's office until her replacement has been made.
2. **BUILDING UPDATE:** The building project continues to move along. The footers have been poured and backfilled on the wash bay portion of the building. The block walls are up in this area. The footers in the apparatus bay will continue to be worked on in the next month. They are building the concrete headers that go over the twenty overhead bay doors. The steel is coming in on two separate deliveries, the first delivery is expected to be here on August 5st and the second delivery on August 19th. We have lost some ground due to the valued engineering changes that were made while waiting for the States approval. We are receiving supplies weekly. During the weekly job meetings none of the vendors are indicating any issues with delays of materials. I continue to be present at the weekly meetings and communicate with Keller daily. If you have any questions please feel free to ask.
3. **VEHICLES:** Unit 267 had both the front and rear air conditioner fail, during the repairs it was also noticed that the radiator was leaking which resulted in replacing it, otherwise just general maintenance was provided this month.
4. **OTHER:** We recently received \$6,983.59 from the (FAP) funding assistance program, we were also notified that we will be receiving \$24,390.23 from ARPA funds from the State of Wisconsin. We received a grant of \$1000.00 from the Alliant Energy grant foundation which will be used for a training simulator. We also received \$1920.00 from the Frank G. Andres Charitable Trust which was used to purchase portable carbon monoxide detectors for the crews. To keep you informed we recently went through the revalidation process for Medicaid. We have another full-time paramedic that has signed up for critical care training which will help our service grow in the right direction.

Of these 125 requests, we have accepted 16.
